

P.A. AARENSLAAGTE (Unknown District)

Opened 7 Jun 1884. Closure date unknown. No recorded mark.

P.A. AASVOGELKOP (Bloemfontein District)

Opened 1894. Closed intermittently during the war. Reopened 6 Oct 1900. Closed circa 1902. No recorded mark.

P.A. AASVOGELKRANS (Heilbron District)

Sometimes AASVOGELKRANTZ. Opened Oct 1894. Closed circa 1908. No recorded mark.

P.A. AASVOGELRAND (Vredefort District)

Opened 15 Nov 1905. Still open in 1910.

S.O. ABERFELDY (Harrismith District)

Formerly P.A. ELANDS RIVER. Renamed 1 July 1905. S.O. 1 Oct 1905. P.A. Jan 1906 when it transferred to ABERFELDY RAIL.

R.S.T.O. ABERFELDY RAIL (Harrismith District)

Opened 15 Oct 1902 as R.T.O. ABERFELDY STATION. In 1903 listed as R.O. and in Jan 1906 as R.S.T.O. when it absorbed S.O. ABERFELDY. Still open in 1910.

P.A. ABRAHAMSKRAAL (Bloemfontein District)

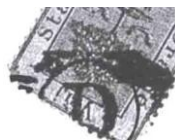

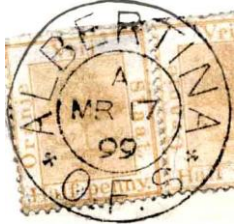

Opened April 1903 when it absorbed P.A. ALBERTINA with its Type 5 which continued to be used. S.O. Jul 1903. Renamed SWINBURNE RAIL 1 Aug 1906.

S.O. ALLANDALE (Winburg District)

Opened as P.A. in 1879. Closed intermittently during the war. Reopened 15 Oct 1902. S.O. 25 Jan 1906. Still open in 1910.

S.O. ARBEIDS KOLONIE (Rouxville District)

Opened 15 Dec 1909. Renamed GOEDE MOED 1 Aug 1910. No recorded mark.

ARMY MANOEUVRES TEMPORARY POST OFFICES

T.O. BISHOP'S GLEN (Bloemfontein District)

Open 16 Sept 1904 – 24 Sept 1904. No recorded mark.

P.O. WATERWORKS (Bloemfontein District)

Open 15 Sept 1904 – 24 Sept 1904. No recorded mark.

P.A. TWEESPRUIT CAMP (Thaba 'Nchu District)

Opened and closed 31 Oct 1904. No recorded mark.

S.O. AUSTIN'S POST (Bloemfontein, later Edenburg, District)

Sometimes AUSTENS POST and AUSTINSPOST. Opened as P.A. 15 Apr 1906. S.O. 15 Dec 1908. Still open in 1910.
