**P.A. JACKHALSKRAAL** (Winburg District)

Sometimes JAKHALSKRAAL. Opened 1 Jan 1909. Still open in 1910.

Opened 1867. Occupied 14 Feb 1900. Reopened by 23 Jun 1900. Still open in 1910.

Opened as **P.A. 1890** and situated where Jagersfontein Road terminated at the railway line 40 klms from Jagersfontein. R.O. opened 1891. Closed early 1900. *Transferred* to R.T.O. Jagersfontein Road 1 Sep 1902. T.O. reopened 15 Nov 1902 and operated by Central South African Railways from 1906. Still open in 1910.

Sometimes JAMMERBERGDRIFT. **Opened 1884.** Closure date unknown. Reopened Jan 1892. Closed during war. Reopened 25 May 1903. Closed May 1904. Reopened 15 Aug 1904. Still open in 1910.
