Until evidence is supplied to the contrary, cancellers with the name DRIEFONTEIN will be listed under the office in the Heilbron District.

P.A. DRIEFONTEIN (Heilbron District)

Opened Jan 1892. Transferred to GELDERLAND 31 Jan 1899. Reopened 15 Apr 1903 as DRIEFONTEIN. Renamed KLEINFONTEIN 15 Aug 1906.
