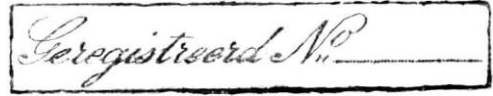

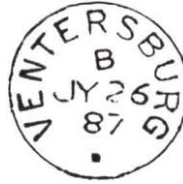

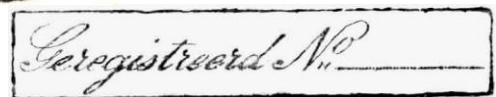

Opened 9 Aug 1901 when it absorbed P.O. VREDEFORT ROAD with its **Type 726A** which continued to be used. Closed 8 Sep 1902.

P.A. VREDEVLEI (Winburg District)

Opened 18 Dec 1902. Closed Jun 1903. No recorded mark.

P.A. VROOLYKSFONTEIN (Kroonstad District)

Sometimes VROOLIJKSFONTEIN. Opened 1 Nov 1903. Closed 20 Jun 1906. No recorded mark.
